This demand is submitted on behalf of Vice Presidents Denise Watts, Gerard Tcheumani, and Sandra Lee.

Local 1061 hereby submits a **Demand to Bargain** over the following changes related to the Return to Office (RTO) initiative:

- 1. **Return to Office (RTO) Implementation** –Briefing/Pre-Decisional Involvement Impact on affected employees, including working conditions, workload, and transition timelines.
- 2. **Space Committee** Transparency and Union participation in decisions related to office space allocation and shared workspaces.
- 3. **Parking** Addressing parking availability, location, and accommodations for employees returning to physical workspaces.
- 4. **50-Mile Radius Policy** Clarification on how this policy is being applied and its impact on employees required to return to the office.
- 5. **Exempted Groups/Employees** –Criteria and processes for determining which employees or positions may be exempt from RTO.

We request a briefing and meeting to discuss these matters and negotiate the impact and implementation of these changes.
